Project Experience

The overview below details Ms. Azarnoush's responsibilities and skills across various sectors:

Bridges:

Ms. Azarnoush contributed to the change order and claims analysis for a major federal bridge renovation in Northern California. Ms. Azarnoush studied contractor's payment requests for contract changes and project claims. This task included providing independent take-offs using traditional 2D drawings, documenting the changes and their associated costs, and presenting the information to the owner in simplified presentations.

Transportation:
